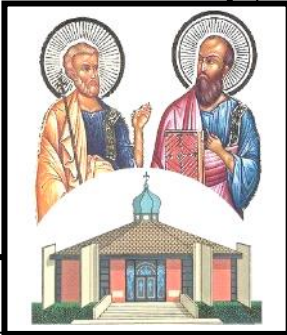

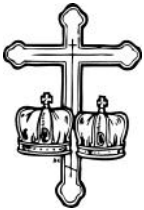

Bible & Faith Study Group

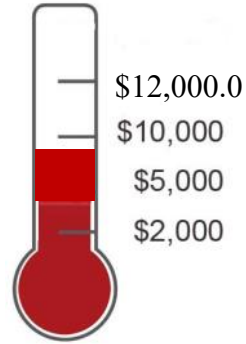

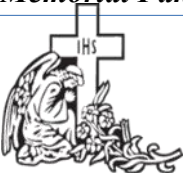
