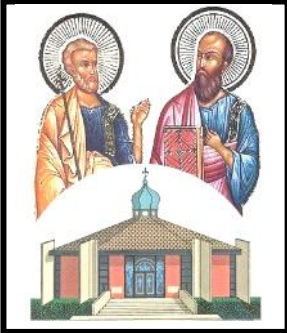

We are expecting more than usual number of kids. The dates are Thursday August 1 & Friday August 2

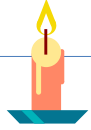
The theme of the Camp is Blast off into God's Galaxy!
